SESSION 1 (LOCATION: PLAVAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL)

CHEER / DANCE

Get ready for a fun class for girls and boys who want to learn and improve their cheer skills. From jumps and motion technique to mini cheer routines, students will practice synchronization, performance skills, and, most importantly...teamwork!
